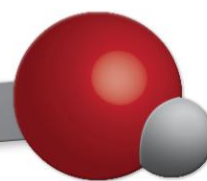

### Unit Description

This unit covers following basic chemical safety rules and defines the standard required to: interpret chemical safety rules; follow safety instructions including handling and storage; use personal protective equipment and communicate information about spillage or accidents. This unit applies to the observance of the basic chemical safety rules including those about labels, transport, handling, storage and personal protective equipment.

## Employability Skills

Employability skills are generic skills that are required in all work situations. For each qualification, an employability skills summary is included as part of the standards for a Training Package. All VET courses are standardised with employability skills. This unit contains employability skills;

## Session Plan and Delivery Methodology
